



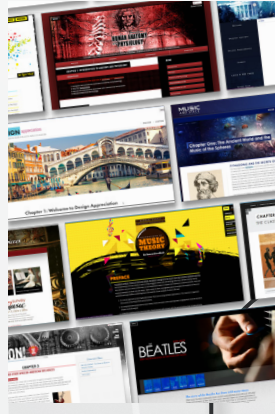
Your assigned Publishing Specialist will be your main contact, along with your editor, throughout the entire publishing process and beyond.

2 Blueprint

The Publishing Specialist, Editor, and Web Team hold a conference call with you to brainstorm your project, create a custom blueprint for your title's user experience, and decide on a writing plan that will be the roadmap to the initial launch.

4 Web Design



Based on the project our team will use either a high-end core design or our designers will craft a custom design based on your original concept/subject matter.

3 Writing

Once a plan is established, your Publishing Specialist will configure your Shareroom (our file collaboration site) where you will submit your manuscript materials.

Permissions

Borrowing content from other authors? Our permissions department will facilitate the clearance process. They can take months, so please submit borrowed content 3-6 months prior to final due date. Being a web title we can also take advantage of linking to other resources to supply students with easy access to additional material.

Copyediting

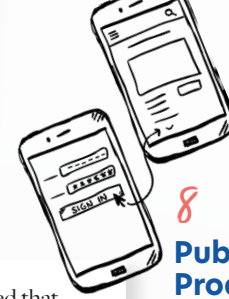
The manuscript will be reviewed using an agreed-upon reference style for punctuation corrections, spelling, and grammar.

Prototype and Proofing

Starting with one complete chapter, our team will build and create a prototype implementing your content into the blueprint and design we discussed. This gives you an opportunity to see your web publication come to life and may help inform your writing for remaining chapters.
